We will be comparing the lives of nurses today compared with nurses in the past.</p>	<p>Geography This will be covered in Spring 2 during 'Our Local Area'.</p>
<p>Maths: We will be learning all about money, including counting coins and making different amounts. We will also continue to develop our multiplication and division skills. We will be making tally charts, interpreting and drawing pictograms as well as totalling and comparing categorical data.</p>		<p>Art and Design: We will be linking our Art lessons to our Science topic on Plants. We will be developing our drawing skills by completing observational drawings of plants and trees.</p>	
<p>Science: Year 2 will be looking at Plants. In this unit the children have the opportunity to closely study plants and trees in the natural environment, taking measurements and making observational drawings. The children will plant a seed and a bulb and compare them as they grow. They will record changes in their plants.
